This month you get to make your own Mr. Monitor papercraft toy. All you need are some scissors and an x-acto knife (and maybe some tape). First cut out the shapes below along the solid lines. The dotted lines are where you will have to fold.

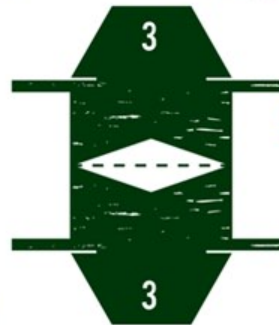


For the head, cut small slits in tab 1, lines 6 and 7 and the line on the top of the head (amongst the scales). Fold the head and curve it over so tab 2 is inserted in the slit in tab 1. Cut and fold the hat and insert tab 3 into the slit on the top of the head.

For the body, cut and fold out the arms before cutting out the body shape. Cut a slit in tab 4 and, after folding, insert tab 5 in tab 4. Attach the head to the body by inserting tabs 6 and 7 into the slits on the bottom of the head. Stand Mr. Monitor on the base and show him off to your friends!
